



2025 Large Waste Policy

Due to the increased volume of regular and large waste and increase in transportation fees, the municipality is enacting the following large waste drop off policy.

Anything not able to fit in a tied garbage bag is considered large waste and will no longer be picked up. Large waste will **NOW ONLY** be accepted **at the drop off site** located at **499 route 301 (chemin du Depotoir)** between the hours of **10 a.m. and 2 p.m.** on the dates stated below.

Metal items accepted

- ✓ Fridges
- ✓ Stoves
- ✓ Bicycles
- ✓ Barrels
- ✓ Tin
- ✓ Fans
- ✓ Poles
- ✓ Etc.

*** Construction Items are NOT ACCEPTED ***

(Any and all construction materials)

- ✗ Lumber
- ✗ Boards or particle board
- ✗ Drywall
- ✗ Insolation
- ✗ Shingles
- ✗ Windows or wooden doors
- ✗ Plywood
- ✗ Vinyl siding
- ✗ Concrete blocks
- ✗ Tare paper or tar
- ✗ Flooring of any type including rolls of carpet
- ✗ And all other construction material
